AGE DIVISIONS & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Age Divisions

8 & under (born 2019-2017)
9 - 10 (born 2016-2015)
11 - 12 (born 2014-2013)
13 - 14 (born 2012-2011)
15 - 16 (born 2010-2009)
17 - 18 (born 2008-2006)
* Athletes born in 2006 are also eligible if they do not turn 19 on or before 7/29/2025



<u>Individuals:</u> Athletes must compete in his/her age division only. There will be no "moving up" in any events, including relays. Competitors in the 8 & under, 9 - 10, and 11 - 12 age divisions may compete in a maximum of three (3) events, including relays. Competitors in the 13 - 14, 15 - 16, and 17 - 18 age divisions may compete in a maximum of four (4) events, including relays. Proof of Age may be requested during the event. Please be prepared to show proof of age if asked. (i.e., Copy of Birth Certificate)

Relay Teams: Athletes can register up to 6 names for relays. Relay change forms will be available before the contested events. Any Relays added must be already registered in the Meet. There will be a fee for any added Relays. All athletes representing the club must be affiliated with and members of that club. Uniforms should be consistent and will be checked by the Clerks.

WAIVERS: All athletes participating in the 17th Annual Mark Trail Memorial Day Invite must complete the Participant Waiver and Release form. This form is already integrated into the online entry system and can be completed electronically; it can also be obtained onsite at the Meet. All forms must be submitted before the first competition.

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded for 1st thru 3rd for each event. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th thru 8th places for each event. Individual age groups will be awarded

Please assign a Team Parent or Contact to pick up Medals for athletes. No awards will be given to individual athletes.

ATHLETE INDIVIDUAL TROPHIES will be awarded for each Male Age Division Champion, and each Female Age Division Champion and Outstanding Athlete Awards (based on Age Groups)

TEAM TROPHIES will be awarded to 4 classes based on Team sizes.

Class A 76 or more Athletes
Class B 51-75 Athletes
Class C 26-50 Athletes
Class D 25 or Less Athletes

9:00 AM SHOT PUT (Female) (WILL START WITH 8 and under BOYS Rolling schedule 9:00 AM HIGH JUMP (Male) (will start with 9 and 10 at 9:00 a.m.) 8:00 AM LONG JUMP (WILL START WITH 17 and 18 MEN and move down each MALE category

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be separate check-in areas for Running and Field events. Field Event Athletes will check in at their designated Field event locations. Athletes must check in at these designated areas 30-45 minutes before the event's scheduled starting time. All athletes will be required to remain in the designated warm-up areas after checking in.

<u>COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS</u>: All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during the competition and on the front of their jerseys only. If an athlete loses their bib number, a replacement can be purchased for \$10.00. Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes at the Timing Tent located at the Finish Line on the Track.

EVENT RESULTS: During the competition, event results will be posted **online Only at ptgrouponline.com**). In addition, event results from preliminaries will be posted on the building where the coaches' lounge is located.

<u>PROTESTS</u>: There will be a \$50.00 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Meet Referee and Games Committee at once and must be submitted not later than 30 minutes after a result has been posted/announced. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
